
ReadyMass 100

MassEcon, MOITI, U.S. Department of Commerce, and MOBD recently met with representatives from a Dutch technology company. Company officials are considering Greater Boston, North Carolina, and other states for a large R&D/manufacturing campus development totaling more than 300,000 SF with 200 employees. Once the company selects a state to expand, they will pursue local real estate options. Update: States under consideration include Massachusetts, southern New Hampshire, Georgia, and North Carolina (Raleigh-Durham). MassEcon and a member real estate firm have been assisting company officials and their business consultant with a site search strategy for Massachusetts.

MassEcon was asked to provide research and information in support of the project. The consultant has not commenced the real estate phase of the project.
