
#ICYMI: March Members Meeting Presentation

#2876: MassEcon was contacted by an Atlanta-based location incentives consultant representing an underwater drone company based in Fall River and considering a 20,000 SF expansion in Westport, Fall River, or Rhode Island. MassEcon assisted the real estate firm by making connections to appropriate state agencies regarding incentives.

#2877: MassEcon was contacted by a New York-based site location consultant representing a 50,000 SF and 500 employees inbound e-commerce call center client. The company plans to open three call centers in different markets between Q3 2018 and Q3 2019. Springfield and Pittsfield were both evaluated. The consultant submitted their report to the client and they have decided to visit Pittsfield and Springfield at the end of May for meetings with local and regional economic development officials.
