



2020 Site Location by the Numbers







Sample Site Location Projects

Win: MassEcon and partners have successfully worked with Ultragenyx. MassEcon worked directly with the corporate real estate executives and provided expertise around site selection. Ultragenyx will build a 100,000 SF gene therapy manufacturing facility in Bedford at 170 Middlesex Turnpike. Ultragenyx will employ 100-150 people.

Win: Rangine Corp. based in Needham will be relocating to Westborough at 254 Turnpike Road. The company will occupy 37,000 SF of manufacturing space to build custom architectural shelving. The company will employ 50 people at full capacity.

Win: Tufts Health Plan/Harvard Pilgrim Health Care: MassEcon assisted WDG Consulting in New Jersey with the labor market analysis of the Canton area for the 300 customer service positions moving from Watertown to the Former Reebok campus in Canton

Win: MassEcon worked to introduce MA incentives and state partners to Colliers International's client Vibalogics GmbH which is investing \$150 million in 118,00 square feet. The German CDMO plans a viral manufacturing site in Boxborough at 1414 Massachusetts Ave. It is starting with 100 employees and hopes to reach 250 employees in the next four years.


