

#2863: MassEcon is working with a large UK-based consulting firm considering having a small office presence in Boston, and first office in the U.S. SelectUSA referred the company to MassEcon who will be meeting with company officials in early 2018. The office will represent 15-20 employees to start, in roughly 5,000 SF with future expansion likely.

#2848: Project Galaxy represents a well-known national corporation looking for a new location for a warehouse/distribution center for consumer products. The client is looking statewide for 1.2 million SF, will develop and own the facility, and will employ 1,000 people (150 management/professional positions and 850 warehouse positions). CT, RI, NH, and NY are also being considered. Update: After several community visit, MA locations are still in the running. The consulting team will be evaluating workforce and incentives programs in each of the candidate states in early January.

#2777 Win: Astellas Institute for Regenerative Medicine: Astellas will invest \$80 million to convert a 250,000 SF office building at 9 Technology Drive in Westborough into a pharmaceutical research and development facility. The company plans to employ between 200 and 300 workers in the Westborough location. MassEcon directly assisted the consultant and real estate firm with this project.
