#2902: Project Independence II

MassEcon, EDC of Western Mass, and MOBD are working with a location consultant based in Memphis representing a client (HQ outside the Northeast) that needs a location for a Northeast distribution center. Total facility build-out will be 1 million SF on 80 acres. 200-300 employees hired locally. *Update: The consulting team along with the company executives will be visiting Southwick in early March.* 

#2920: Project Tarmac

MassEcon was contacted by a Dallas based site selection firm representing a manufacturer needing a min. of 75 contiguous acres for industrial development with runway/tarmac access, with a preference for 150 acres. The project will require a 10,000' runway. Working with the EDC of Western Mass and City of Westfield, based on land availability and runway length, both Westover and Barnes airports were submitted as the two site candidates in Massachusetts.



Pete Abair convened an orientation meeting for MassEcon's new board directors, which included longer service directors and committee chairs. Pete continues to work with the team to augment business intelligence research capacity in order to share key business insight with members and partners.
