MassEcon and partners are working with a Chicago-based consultant representing a 600,000 SF manufacturing prospect, 130 jobs, \$100M 4-year investment. Considering a 125-mile radius of Albany. Two sites in Chicopee and one in Charlton are being considered. *Update: The Chicago based consultant has informed MassEcon their client has cancelled the project because they have decided not to expand operations at this time.*

#2939: MassEcon and partners are assisting a Korea-based biologics company looking for 4,300 SF of wet lab space and lease rates within the Metro Boston market. Thank you to Avison Young for providing real estate expertise to assist with this requirement.
