#2884: A Phoenix-based labor market consultant contacted MassEcon with a request for information for a headquarters relocation project considering Boston. MassEcon provided the consultant with information on other headquarters located in Boston, recent company expansions, recent company layoffs, and employer/staffing agency interviews. Real estate and incentives will be evaluated at a later date if Boston makes the short list. Other Northeast U.S. cities are being considered. Update: Consultant has several calls set up with its client over the next few weeks.

#2879: MassEcon and partners from MOBD and MassDevelopment were working with a global company in the technology industry that considered Massachusetts for a potential office and R&D/lab operation. The company needed 15,000 SF of flex space for 20 employees and evaluated properties from Franklin, the South Coast, and Rhode Island. Properties from Franklin down to the South Coast are being reviewed. Rhode Island is also being considered. Update: The company, iXBlue, announced its plan to relocate to Rhode Island.

NOTE: With several companies having been in play in MA making decisions to locate in Rhode Island, MassEcon is in the process of gathering information about their decisions. Summer on Dewey kicked off on July 11 and will run through September 13, welcoming the public to enjoy the summer weather with special offerings in Dewey Square Park on the Greenway. Read more here.

MassDevelopment approved a \$2 million loan to past Economic Impact Award winner Berkshire Sterile Manufacturing Inc. for the expansion of the company's sterile manufacturing facility in Lee. Read more here.

Sanofi Genzyme will award \$43,000 to MassBay Community College's STEM Mentor Program for the 2018-2019 academic year, marking the fourth year that Sanofi Genzyme has funded the mentorship program. Read more here.

#2877: MassEcon was contacted by a New York-based site location consultant representing an inbound e-commerce call center client requiring 50,000 SF to accommodate 500 employees. The company plans to open three call centers in different markets between Q3 2018 and Q3 2019, with both Springfield and Pittsfield under consideration. Update: Consultant and company officials visited Springfield and Pittsfield in June, and toured real estate options in each market.

#2857 Win: Akcea Therapeutics, a drug development company, will lease 30,000 SF at 22 Boston Wharf Road in Boston and create 50 new jobs.

#2835 Under Agreement: A confidential medical device company will build-to-suit a new 45,000 SF headquarters for office/manufacturing use in Beverly.
