#2935: Project Slap Shot

MassEcon and partners are working with a New Jersey-based site consultant representing a communications/technology company considering Metro Boston and two other U.S. metros. The company will employ 400-500 highly skilled people. The consultant is conducting interviews with staffing firms and employers in the region to better understand the local labor market.

Last month, the member companies of the Venture Development Center (the self-funded incubator based at **UMass**Boston), reached a milestone: more than \$1 billion in funding in 10 years. Read more here. Additionally, UMass ranks 37th on the "Top 100" Worldwide Universities Granted U.S. Patents in 2018" list released by the National Academy of Inventors and the Intellectual Property Owners Association. This is the sixth consecutive year UMass has landed on the list, and the university rose eight places in this year's rankings. With 58 patents awarded in calendar year 2018, UMass ranks first among public universities in New England, third overall in New England, and 30th overall in the U.S. Read more here. In this role, starting July 29, she will head offices in Amherst and at the Mount Ida Campus of UMass Amherst in Newton. Read more here.
