

Number of MassEcon-assisted Projects








2022 v 221 Site Location Snapshot

Projects by Use Type



13 Wins have announced in 2022 representing **400,000 SF** and over **1,000 jobs**.

Soliyarn, LLC will renovate 21,000 SF building in Lynn for manufacturing and R&D. Soliyarn will create 105 new fulltime jobs, retain seven existing jobs, and make a private investment of \$7.75 million.

Factorial, Inc. a solid-state battery technology for electric vehicles will lease and renovate 78,000 SF at 501 Griffin Brook Drive in Methuen and create 136 new full-time jobs, retain 30 existing jobs, investment of \$45 million.

Project Anchor: **Eli Lilly Institute for Genetic Medicine**, an investment \$700 million n the Boston Seaport, projects 130 new jobs in 334,000 sq. ft. of leased space. MassEcon teamed with MLSC.

Aegle, 3,000 SF, 12 new full-time jobs, Cummings Center, Beverly. MassEcon teamed with MOBD.

Bisousweet Confections, 10,000 SF, 70 new and retained jobs, \$2.8M investment, Leominster. MassEcon teamed with MOBD.





Our Impact

In FY2021, the agency financed or managed



- 416 projects generating investment of more than

Brockton Beer Company





In September 2021, MassDevelopment provided a **\$430,000 loan to Brockton Beer Company**, which used proceeds for working capital, equipment purchases, and other startup costs.

This Black-owned business, founded by four friends from Brockton, is the **city's first craft brewery**. The taproom officially opened in June 2022.





City Fresh Foods

MassDevelopment recently provided **\$4 million** in **loan financing** to **City Fresh Foods**, a Black- & employee-owned food service business. The loan will help the company make renovations to its new facility **in Roxbury** and create jobs.

East Coast Seafood

In 2021, MassDevelopment provided a **\$602,000 loan** to **East Coast Seafood, LLC**, a seafood processor and distributor in **New Bedford**. The company used loan proceeds to buy new equipment, install updated technology, increase packaging options, and adjust order logistics.

MassDevelopment **partnered with BankFive** to provide **\$11.9 million in Ioan financing** to Standard Holdings, LLC, which is using funds to build and equip a three-story 53-unit mixed-income apartment complex in Hyannis.

MassDevelopment enhanced the financing with a guarantee.





Nubian Square Ascends

MassDevelopment recently **partnered with six area lenders to provide loan financing to Nubian Ascends Partners, LLC** for predevelopment work at Nubian Square Ascends, a planned mixed-use development located in Nubian Square. Nubian Square Ascends plans to be an employment, cultural, and social hub of the Roxbury community.

Six lenders provided a **\$3 million loan**, which MassDevelopment **enhanced with a guarantee**.
