



Eversource is New England's largest energy delivery company, safely and reliably delivering energy to more than 4 million electric, natural gas, and water customers in Connecticut, Massachusetts and New Hampshire.

- 4,270 miles of electric transmission lines
- 72,000 miles of electric distribution lines
- 6,500 miles of natural gas distribution lines
- 578 electric substations

220,000 natural gas customers

Massachusetts: 1.5 million electric customers (139 C/T)

283,000 natural gas customers (51 C/T)



Eversource: A Strategic Economic Development Partner

New Partnerships/Acquisitions:

Aquarion Water Company

- December 2017 Acquired New England's largest private water company.
- Aquarion provides nearly 230,000 customers with drinking water in the same service states.
- Ørsted global leader in offshore wind
 - February 2019 we entered into a 50-50 partnership for key offshore wind assets in the Northeast. 2 wind projects (Revolution Wind – RI - and South Fork Wind – Long Island) and 257 square mile tact off of the coasts of MA & RI
 - Joint bid selected by New York in July
 Sunrise Wind (880MW)
 - Partnership now subscribed for 2,200 megawatts of offshore wind



Keeping the lights on

Reliability focus:

- Ongoing investments in upgrades and improvements to Eversource's electric, natural gas and water delivery systems
- Invested a record \$2.83 billion in our core business in 2018.
- These investments not only improved reliability and connected new customers but also supported New England's goals to sharply reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- 14 active / planned Transmission Projects in Massachusetts.
- Distribution automation and drones are in the field.
- Manage vegetation
- Strong reliability makes our area attractive to business, while our investment boosts the economy





Catalyst for Clean Energy & Grid Modernization

- \$200M investment in MA solar development (2018)
- Battery storage approved on Cape, Vineyard
- \$45M investment approved to help expand MA EV charger network
- The premise of Grid Mod is the deployment of field devices and integrated I.T. systems allowing us to:
 - remotely acquire information from the field;
 - have the ability to use that data to either predict system conditions and prepare appropriately;
 - control the related devices in order to prevent or minimize negative impacts to our customers






Battery Storage: Projects

Outer Cape Project - \$40M

- 25 MW lithium ion battery installed on single line with no redundancy
- Housed in 7,600 sq. ft. building in Provincetown
- Will provide backup power during an outage
 - Peak: up to 3 hours
 - Off-Peak: up to 10 hours
- In service: 2021

Martha's Vineyard Project - \$15M

- 5 MW lithium battery to replace 2 diesel peaking units
- Housed in 6,000 sq. ft. building in Oak Bluffs
- In service: 2021



Martha's Vineyard Project






EV Make-Ready Program Overview

- \$45 million program for the deployment of Electric
 Vehicle Infrastructure in Eversource service territory.
- 5 year program (2018-2022)
- Deployment of approximately 3,500 Level 2 and DC Fast charging stations throughout Eversource electric service territory.
- Proposal will not result in Eversource owning the charging stations
- "Make-Ready" program will shift cost of "behind the meter" charging infrastructure from the site host to Eversource



Cape Cod Tornado Response

- Unexpected storm brought 90-MPH winds, extensive damage
- Crews worked around the clock to restore 106,000 customers
- Restoration work completed two days ahead of schedule
- Storm response praised by customers & local leaders
