Bousquet Ski Area in Pittsfield is the oldest ski area in Berkshire County. After its acquisition in 2020 by Mill Town Capital, a 2-year \$11.3M renovation led to the construction of a new 2-story, 17,500 square foot base lodge and Lift BistroPub. Bristol Myers Squibb, a global biopharmaceutical company, is the inaugural winner of the Massachusetts Summit Achievement Award for its commitment over time to Massachusetts. In 2007, BMS won an Impact Award for its initial facility investment at Devens. In 2016, BMS won an additional Impact Award for its expansion. In 2022, BMS completed two expansions (in Devens and Cambridge). <u>bms.com</u>



Brockton Beer Company was founded by five Brockton families with a desire to contribute to the revitalization efforts of Downtown Brockton. The founders invested \$1.1M into a 2.2K SF space, which created 15 new jobs. <u>brocktonbeer.com</u>



Catania Oils is a fourth-generation family-owned olive oil manufacturer. Headquartered in Ayer, the company recently completed construction of a 50K SF on-site expansion. They're investing \$14M and plan to create 30 new jobs over a five-year period. <u>cataniaoils.com</u>



Edwards is the leading developer and manufacturer of sophisticated vacuum products, exhaust management systems, and related value-added services. The company invested \$50M in a new Haverhill location. In less than 2 years, the headcount has grown by 25%. <u>edwardsvacuum.com</u>

In 2022, Monogram Foods invested \$35M in a 57K SF bakery facility in Medford which now employs 90 people. They also invested \$42M in a 144K SF production/warehouse facility in Haverhill, the company's first new build, resulting in 131 new hires. <u>monogramfoods.com</u>



RLS Complete is New England's premier cold storage warehouse. The Sturbridge-based company invested \$28.5M in a highly efficient, new facility. The 83.3K SF facility with 17.9K pallet positions resulted in an added 13 jobs. <u>rlslogistics.com</u>





Thermo Fisher Scientific Inc, the world leader in serving science, is strategically focused on expanding its pharma services network. The company invested \$300M in a new state-of-theart 640K SF facility in Plainville. The GMP-compliant facility will add approximately 300 jobs. <u>thermofisher.com</u>

Vertex is a global biotechnology company that invests in scientific innovation to create transformative medicines for people with serious diseases. Vertex invested \$180M in a 250K SF expansion on Northern Ave in Boston. The expansion resulted in 400 new jobs. <u>vrtx.com</u>



Vicor produces innovative, high-density power modules from its automated manufacturing operations in Andover. The company invested \$75M in a 90K SF expansion in 2022, which enabled the creation of the world's first vertically integrated ChiP (Converter housed in Package) fab to support a new era of power module performance. The company plans to create dozens of jobs. <u>vicorpower.com</u>



Watson-Marlow is the world leader in niche peristaltic pump and fluid path technologies, serving life sciences, medical device, food and beverage, and environmental applications. The company invested \$106M in a 150K SF state-of-the-art facility located on the remediated Fort Devens military base, which created 150 new jobs. <u>wmfts.com</u>
