Project Apple: MassEcon is working closely with a NJ-based location consultant representing a global education company considering expanding one of its divisions in Massachusetts. The company would lease 30K SF of office space and employ 50 people. MassEcon assisted the consultant with a field work visit and evaluation of labor markets by setting up meetings with education-related companies, recruiting firms, residential relocation firm, educational innovators, and economic development partners.
