#2927: Project Iris

MassEcon, MOBD, MLSC, MassBio, and MassDevelopment are working with a Chicago-based site consultant representing a biopharmaceutical manufacturer considering MA and other states. The company will have a 180,000-250,000 SF facility. The consultant and company officials recently visited Massachusetts to tour real estate options and meet with employers. Properties in Devens, Boxborough, and Waltham are being evaluated as potential locations for the project.

Update: MassEcon has heard from the site consultant, and next steps for this project will be decided by mid-June.

#2902: Project Independence II

MassEcon, EDC of Western Mass, and MOBD are working with a location consultant based in Memphis representing a client (based in Memphis) that needs a location for a Northeast distribution center. Total facility build-out will be near 1-million SF. 230 employees hired locally.

Update: Unfortunately, MA lost this project to upstate NY. The site consultant informed the team that incentives and timing with securing a sewer easement were the limiting factors for the Southwick, MA site. The team (with the property owner) had a meeting to de-brief the project and better prepare for the next one.
