

# **Projects**

#### #2650

MassEcon, the BRA, and MOBD are working with a Boston- based produce distributor seeking to buy 40,000-50,000 SF of industrial space with 20,000 SF of refrigeration. The building will need 25' clear height in the dry storage area. The company, which currently employs 60 full-time and 50 part-time workers, prefers to stay in the City of Boston or in an adjacent community in order to retain their current workforce. They anticipate that 20-25 new jobs will be added along with the expansion.

#### #2649

An out-of-state site selection team is representing a client with a national search for 30,000-50,000 SF (400-600 seats) of plug-and-play call center space. This search is limited to facilities that have been previously used as a call center or custom-built to serve as a call center. Standard office space and big box retail buildings will not qualify for this search. Between 700 and 100 full-time employees are anticipated over multiple shifts. **Note: Properties in West Bridgewater, Westborough, Andover, Lowell, and Lawrence are being evaluated.** 

#### #2643

MassEcon is working with MLSC and MOBD in assisting a life sciences company with operations in Massachusetts. The company will be consolidating four national locations into two and will need 150,000 SF of office/lab space and 70,000 SF of manufacturing space within the same facility or on the same campus. The company anticipates adding 200 new employees in Massachusetts.

Update: At the request of the MLSC, MassEcon organized a team of officials from MOBD and Newmark Grubb Knight Frank to visit this company at one of their MA locations. Note: New Jersey, North Carolina, and Massachusetts are all being considered as locations for the consolidation.
