Projects

#2804: Project Anchor:

MassEcon is working with a Cleveland-based site consulting and engineering firm who is assisting an advanced manufacturing company with the selection of a location for a new production facility in the Northeast U.S. The search area includes Bristol and Plymouth counties. Optimal size of buildout will be 100,000 SF, but will consider buildings from 30,000 SF (if expandable) to 150,000. This project represents 125 new jobs. The company currently does not have operations in Massachusetts.

#2805: Project Mangrove:

MassEcon and MLSC are working with a Washington, D.C.-based strategic consulting team member of a major real estate firm. They are assisting a life sciences company considering Greater Boston, among other short listed locations outside Massachusetts. At this point, the consultant is evaluating the incentives in each of the short listed locations. The real estate search process will follow. Job count unknown at this time.

#2806: Project Gamma:

MassEcon is working with a Raleigh, NC-based strategic consulting team member of a major real estate firm. They are representing a financial services company considering Boston and Cambridge. This project represents 200-300 new high paying jobs. MassEcon will be setting up meetings with employers, recruiting firms, and universities so the consultant and client can complete field work in order to evaluate the local labor market. The company currently does not have operations in Massachusetts.
