A Pittsburgh based site consultant is representing a Fortune 100 company seeking to buy 80 usable acres to build a 500,000+ SF hub-distribution facility using a phased build-out approach. The company is considering land sites only, industrially zoned preferred, but will also consider land that needs to be re-zoned. More than 100 people will be employed at this facility. Good highway access is extremely important. Note: Eastern NY, CT, and RI are also being considered. Update: The site consultant has expressed further interest in a large site in Westfield, owned by Equity Industrial Partners

A Phoenix-based consultant is representing a translation services company, also headquartered in Phoenix, looking to lease a 50-200 seat high quality "plug and play" call center. The building must be located in a safe, generally clean area, with access to public transit. The company has found success in the past in utilizing space formerly occupied by financial institution call centers, which tend to have similar requirements. 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time zone of the United States.

Note: The building must be located in close proximity to a workforce of natural speakers of at least one of the following languages: Mandarin, Vietnamese, Arabic, Korean, Russian, Cantonese, Haitian Creole, Nepali, Somali, Burmese. A concentration in 1 to 3 languages is preferred at the call center

Update: MassEcon and the City of Lowell have been working with the consultant to further evaluate plug-and-play space at Cross Point in Lowell. 1441 Main St. in Springfield is also under consideration.

MassEcon and MOBD are in the early stages of working with a confidential energy related company that is seeking to purchase up to 100 acres in the Blackstone Valley, or along I-90 or I-91 Corridors for a large development. Access to an interstate natural gas pipeline is necessary as well as convenient truck access to an interstate highway. Note: The land needs to be zoned for industrial or commercial use, or can be re-zoned to allow those uses.
