

Projects

#2722: Project Azalea MassEcon coordinated partners from MassBio, MLSC, and MOBD, who met with a Washington D.C. site location consultant representing a major biopharmaceutical company considering a 140,000 SF expansion in Massachusetts. This project represents a \$215 million investment and 320 new jobs. Major biotech hubs in the Eastern U.S. were being considered. Thank you to MassEcon members Ernst & Young for assisting the team with a request for information, and Nutter McClennen & Fish LLP for hosting the meeting at its office in the Seaport District. Update: The company failed Phase III clinical trials. Project could revive again in 12-24 months.

#2840: Project Nuance MassEcon, MLSC, and regional partners were working with a biopharma therapy company that requires 10,000-20,000 SF for a laboratory, production area, offices, and warehouse staging area. The laboratory and production areas will need to be at least 700 SF and have designation of ISO 7 (class 10,000) or better clean room. At this point the search is statewide, but the client is interested in Western MA. The company will hire 100 employees during the initial phase. Update: Although the company was considering Western MA, it is now considering locations south of NYC, where the company's supplier base is predominantly located.

#2848: Project Galaxy represents a well-known national corporation looking for a new location for a warehouse/distribution center for consumer products. The client is looking statewide for 1.2 million SF (existing/expandable or new construction, including parking, on 125+ acres). The client will develop and own the facility and will employ 1,000 people (150 management/professional position and 850 warehouse positions) .The entire Northeast (US) region is being considered. Update: The site location consultants will be in Massachusetts to visit communities and site during the week of October 30.
