

#2790: "Project Boxer" MassEcon, MOBD, and the EDC of Western MA are working with an out-of-state site location consulting firm representing a multi-billion dollar U.S.-based publicly traded corporation. The consulting team is considering sites 100-115 acres in Western MA for a 1.1 million SF distribution facility representing 400 total jobs. Preferred location decision is expected at the end of 2016. A site in Westfield is under consideration. Site options in New York, Connecticut, and New Jersey are also being evaluated.

#2791: MassEcon, MLSC, MOBD, MassBio, and MassDevelopment recently met with a mid-sized German pharma company considering a first-time office presence in Cambridge. The company will hire 10 new people initially and lease a small amount of office space to establish a presence in this market. Potential future expansion will be considered.
