LStar Ventures, a developer of master-planned communities, is building a new city at Union Point, the site of the former naval air station in South Weymouth. The 1500-acre site, which happens to be one of the largest remaining developable parcels in the Boston area, is being built to adapt future technological advances in urban living. Optimus Ride has begun testing autonomous vehicles at Union Point, and GE will use Union Point as a lab for testing new products and as a showroom for working systems. **MassDevelopment** hired four redevelopment experts to help redevelopment initiatives in four cities. Read more here.

#2893: MassEcon has been contacted by a California-based real estate firm representing a major confidential consumer products HQ operation considering downtown Boston. The company already has a presence in Boston and will consider an onsite expansion. MassEcon is expecting more project information from the real estate firm regarding next steps. Update: MassEcon, MOBD, City of Boston, and MassEcon member Winter Wyman have been assisting the real estate firm and client company with the information they need.

#2894: MassEcon, MassBio, MOBD, MLSC, and MassDevelopment are working with a bio-manufacturing prospect that needs 50 acres to build a 250,000 SF facility and land for future expansion, within a 90-minute drive from Cambridge. The company will employ 150 to start. Multiple states and countries are being considered at this time. A site will be selected in mid-2019. Update: MassEcon has submitted 19 sites throughout Massachusetts for review.

**#2895:** MassEcon and the EDC of Western MA have been assisting a Connecticut- based real estate broker representing a Connecticut company considering Western Massachusetts for a bottling facility. A 450,000 SF building is needed, or 15-20 acres to build-tosuit. The client hopes to select a location by Q1 2019.

#2896: MassEcon and MLSC are working with a biomanufacturing client that needs 12,000 SF. Half of the space will be devoted to Biosafety Level (BSL) Class 2 lab, and half to GMP manufacturing. Notes: Turnkey is ideal, but client is willing to fit out space. Multitenant building is fine, but must have own dedicated HVAC system.

# Approval of Economic Development Incentives for Companies Across MA

The state's Economic Assistance Coordinating Council certified five projects that will be eligible to receive investment tax credits (with one company, Humana, eligible for future consideration) as well as local incentives from their host communities. An additional four companies were approved to enter local property-tax agreements with municipalities. These projects are expected to create 890 new jobs, retain 2,121 jobs, and leverage \$136 million in private investment.
