

2936: Win: Simcere Innovation Center will open a 26K SF lab/office in Cambridge Discovery Park. They occupy a small Regus office in Kendall Square. The Cambridge Discovery Park lab/office will be their first lab space in the region. Simcere Pharmaceutical Group (parent co) in China has approximately 4,500 employees. Simcere will employ approximately 100 people within the new space when the building and tenant fit-up is complete in January 2020.

#2939: MassEcon and partners are assisting a Koreabased biologics company looking for 4,300 SF of wet lab space and lease rates within the Metro Boston market. Thank you to Avison Young for providing real estate expertise to assist with this requirement. Update: Company officials are visiting MA in mid-October to tour real estate.

#2943: MassEcon and partners have assisted Commonwealth Fusion Power who is collaborating with MIT's Plasma Science and Fusion Center (PSFC) to site a facility for the world's first machine that will prove the viability of commercial fusion power. CFS and MIT's PSFC are seeking to build a state-of-the-art facility. A 150,000 SF facility will be built on 30 acres. CFS has selected their Top 3 sites: Devens, MIT land (78-acres) in Middleton, and Portsmouth, NH. If Devens is selected it could be a larger scale project to include a prototype facility, advanced manufacturing, and HQ.

MassDevelopment also announced a new arts-based programming it will create through the agency's TDI program for Gateway Cities (designed to accelerate economic growth within focused districts) made possible by a \$500K grant from the Barr Foundation. Read more here.
