MassEcon and the Metro West Chamber of Commerce are working with a California-based clean technology company seeking to purchase or lease a 120,000 - 130,000 SF building within a 50-mile radius of Littleton, MA. The company will employ 30-40 people to start. Sites in Millis, Marlborough, Leominster, and Westminster were visited during the site tour with company officials. Company officials have made an offer on 100 Simplex Drive in Westminster.

#2591:

MassEcon is working with an Atlanta-based site location consultant who is representing a major retailer for a direct-to-consumer fulfillment center. Will consider 85+ acre land sites and 900,000 SF buildings that can be expanded to 1.3 MSF. The SouthCoast Park in Fall River is the only site being considered in Massachusetts. *Update: The site consultant visited the site in July with site representative, NAI Hunneman, and Fall River officials. The project has been delayed for 6-12 months and will be revisited at that time. The company would ultimately hire 800 FT employees*

#2595:

MassEcon is assisting several state and regional economic development partners all working with a custom windows manufacturer headquartered in Germany. The company is seeking to lease or buy 40,000-60,000 SF of manufacturing/assembly, warehouse, and office space with room for future expansion to 75,000-80,000 SF. Twenty five to fifty jobs will be created to start. Central MA, Western MA, and Berkshire County are all regions being considered.


Mid-Year Report

MassEcon's site search activity for the period of January 1st to June 30th of 2013 was documented in our mid-year report.

Did you know?

- MassEcon provided customized support to 36
 companies that were associated with approximately
 3,500 jobs. Customers of MassEcon's Site Finder
 Service sought 3.7 million SF of space and 400 acres
 of land.
- Companies committed to Massachusetts include ESP Solutions (under negotiation) in Taunton and Richline Group, Inc. in Attleboro
- Under the Team Massachusetts umbrella, 5 MassEcon members volunteered services that included design, construction, real estate, labor force, and research expertise to companies considering MA as an expansion location.
