Best in Class Properties

The Marketing Priority Development Sites Committee, under the leadership of **Brian Cohen of RBJ**, completed its task of analyzing nearly 200 properties that were submitted for MassEcon's forthcoming marketing program. Of the initial 200 submissions, 74 have been selected "best in class" properties that reflect a high level of marketability, readiness, regional diversity and use type, and that will attract companies to consider Massachusetts as an expansion location. MassEcon is awaiting the review of Secretary Greg Bialecki to establish the final list. **A special thanks to the Marketing Priority Development Sites Committee for their time and expertise in the review process!**

On the marketing front, MassEcon received 19 proposals from marketing firms interested in serving as the consultant for this project. A total of 12 firms were selected for first interviews over a three day period, and a short list of 3 firms received second interviews on May 12th. Thank you to the evaluation committee for assisting MassEcon with the interview process.
